Academic Achievements

Academic excellence continues to be the foundation of our institution. I am proud to share the commendable performance of our students in the **CBSE Board Examinations**.

Class X (2024–2025)

- **Master Sidhant Singh** secured **457 out of 500 marks**, achieving **91.40%**.

Class XII (2024–2025)

- **Science Stream**
 - **Master Anas Mansoori** scored **449 out of 500 marks** with **89.8%**.
- **Humanities Stream**
 - **Master Saumya Mahajan** emerged as the school topper with **473 out of 500 marks**, securing an outstanding **94.6%**.
- **Commerce Stream**
 - **Km. Sameeksha Jindal** scored **443 out of 500 marks**, achieving **88.6%**.
